Building Update Project News




Our Traditional Poinsettia Garden



Outreach Advent Collections!

The outreach committee have chosen the following groups to support during this Advent Season. We will have posters with gift tags on them to be taken and items purchased and returned to the church. We will be doing this during the entire month of December. Thanks for considering the various groups. Monetary forms are also available.



<u>Laundry Love</u> - vouchers are given once a month. A local laundromat proves the machines. Volunteers provide the clients with the soap, softener, and money for the machines. Volunteers do not touch other's dirty laundry. In some cases, this is the only time that laundry is done for some persons/families- once a month.

<u>Domestic Abuse Shelter</u> - provides women and children a safe place to stay when needed. Donations are accepted through MCSA.

<u>Emmaus Cafe</u> - serves meals each Sunday at First Presbyterian Church. Meals are prepared by the church members and served by members / friends. Lately, they have been serving approx. 70 people a week. This is funded by their church and donations.

<u>Diaper Bank</u> - serves those in need at daycares and family needs. This is a program under United Way. Diapers do NOT have to be a brand name.

MCSA Shelter - We continue to support a room at the facility. Starting January 2025 note the change in the amount per Sunday, we will be collecting (\$35 for each Sunday).



VESTRY SUMMARY NOVEMBER 11, 2024

Meeting summary: Mary Wildermuth led the meeting in the absence of our President and Vice President.

- Rich Carroll's Budget report of October 2024 was run through and approved.
- The Deacons stewardship report stated a total of 30 pledges for \$82,000 as of Nov. 11th had come in.
- The Elders reported on the search for directors for the choir and handbells. Seeing the 2025 Proposed Annual Budget did not include pay for a handbell director—Sue
- Johannsen made a motion to adjust the pay to \$25/hr with 12 hours a month for the vocal choir and 8 hours a month for the bell choir, both for 8 months of the year (\$4000). This increases the proposed 2025 budget by \$200. **Motion carried.**
- The Trustees reported on our Insurance Questionnaire & Risk Audit for a possible reduction in rates. The Vestry also examined and voted on the quote for the final piece of sign from Nagle Sign at \$2993.29. Nagle Signs Inc. wants 50% of the total invoice to start working on the top of the sign. There is \$3000 left in the sign fund. **Motion carried.** Pat Pagel paid \$500 for an outlet to be included on the sign. The Vestry so moved to reimburse Pat for this expense. Guidelines for using the new sign Rev. Kendy Miller said as a 501c3 there should be nothing political, but there was no further guidance. Lisa Allen and the Pastor will be trained on how to programming the sign. If others want to be trained in the future, Pastor or Lisa can hold a training session. Also, Chris Lary made improvements to the parsonage bathroom, but the flooring is broken and some pieces need replaced. Lastly, the HVAC will finally come next Monday, Nov. 18th to start.
- Pastor Paris reported on the notable events since Vestry last met like her continuing education in Colorado, continuing Pub Theology once per month, the Fall Bash, fulfilling her boundaries training, special worship services, and she moved! Lisa Allen will be on vacation from Nov. 18-22. The office will be closed for Thanksgiving on Nov. 28th & 29th. The pastor will take vacation time Nov. 25-27th.
- Last month, the idea of a suggestion box was proposed. A motion was made to install a suggestion box with instructions that anonymous written suggestions will be discarded. **Motion carried.**
- We considered the need to add more processes to our discussions to engage members to speak up on votes. No action taken. At our last meeting, we postponed the technology upgrades vote for Dec 1st with paper ballots. To offer paper ballots at all congregational meetings going forward, the Constitution/Bylaws need to be updated at the Annual Meeting in January. Our intention is to provide time for discussion on Dec. 1 about paper ballots. An amendment to the Constitution may follow based on the content of the Dec. 1 meeting. Carver downstairs bathroom updates on hold. Pew Chairs, flooring, and 'interior design' items are on hold, Mary is building a team. Raffles are done what is the next phase of fundraising? We did not have time to discuss this in November.
- We still need to recruit Vestry members for 2025 and a financial secretary.
- The Vestry also discussed guidance for discarding unused/old/out-of-date materials at the church. Sue Johannsen made a motion will create a gift policy to decide if something can be removed. If a donation is given to the church, it becomes the church's property to determine what happens to it. **Motion carried**.
- ONA suggests a welcome letter to the Rev Robert Ochoa, (anticipated) newly called Conference Minister for the Tri-Conference. Let's invite him to join us for Sunday worship sometime! There was a consensus to write a welcome letter.
- Reports due to Lisa Allen in the church office for the annual booklet before Jan 1st.
- The next meeting will be on Monday, December 9, 2024.
